<u>Never use</u> any detergents such as dish washing liquids, soaps or other cleaners formulated for general household use. Although they may initially remove dirt or spills they will almost certainly cause problems such as rapid re-soiling, colour bleeding and bleaching or other damage to the pile or backing of the carpet.

Caring for your carpet & rugs

Carpet, and wool carpet in particular, is very good at hiding soil and trapping allergens and pollutants. It acts like a giant filter regulating indoor air quality and humidity. However, for it to be effective this 'filter' needs to be cleaned regularly.

Vacuum regularly

Correct and frequent vacuuming will extend the useful life of your carpet by removing grit and dirt that abrade the fibres causing loss of pile density which leads to flattening.

Professional Annual Clean

Then there is the very important issue of appearance. All carpet fibres, including wool, lose their lustre, colour and definition when oily and sticky soil attaches itself to the pile. This type of soil, coming into our homes on our shoes and through air pollution, cannot be removed by vacuuming, it requires thorough cleaning.

To extend the life of your carpet, save money in replacement costs and keep a healthy indoor environment for you and your family, The WoolSafe Organisation, other leading industry bodies and most carpet mills recommend that carpet and rugs are cleaned at least once a year.

Protective Treatment

For carpets and rugs in high traffic areas or at risk from spillages a protector can be applied topically. They slow down soiling and although not 'bullet proof' give you more time to blot up spills, increasing the chances of successful removal. Ask your local WoolSafe Approved Service Provider about the benefits of applying a protector.

Top tips for easy spot removal

General rules for spot removal

- Act immediately
- In case of extensive stains call a WoolSafe Approved Service Provider
- Soak up liquids with white kitchen roll, tissues, toilet roll or clean cloth
- Scoop up or scrape off solids
- Always work from the edge of the spot inwards
- BLOT, do NOT rub
- Use small quantities of WoolSafe Approved spot remover at a time, to a cloth, NOT directly to the spot



- Before applying any spotting agent, pre-test it on an inconspicuous area of the carpet
- When using solvents always ensure there is plenty of fresh air ventilation and use gloves.
- Always thoroughly rinse out water-based spotters with clean water
- Align cut pile carpet with your fingers.
